

TWO STARS AND A WISH FEEDBACK



Instructions

Use the two stars and a wish strategy described below to provide feedback.



1. Identify two positive aspects of the story and/or performance.

2. Provide star feedback that highlights two areas where the comedic storytelling is strong. Be specific. For example:

- "I want to give you a star for the way you made eye contact with your audience. It helped make the audience feel connected and engaged with what you were saying."
- I like the way you described your character. I formed a clear picture of what she looked like in my mind.
- "I also want to give you a star for your impressions. The way you changed your voice to imitate the angry teacher made me laugh."

3. Identify an area of the work that could be improved.

4. Provide wish feedback on one aspect of the story and/or performance that could be improved. Ensure the feedback is actionable. For example:

- I wish you could add some exciting dialogue to your story. I was curious about what the character might have said or thought when he opened his locker.
- "I think it would be easier for the audience to pay attention if you didn't fidget or move around as much. Be mindful of your posture and body language. It helps to engage your audience."
